Our guest speaker, Don Jo hnston, will speak about the Mississippi Madawaska Land Trust and the role of land trusts in the protection of s ensitive wetlands.

Wetlands mitigate flooding, store carbon and provide habitat for a diverse range of species, making them significant nature-based climate solution powerhouses. Lanark County has significant areas of wetlands, so many of us may not feel that there is a shortage. Since the planning of the Caivan development on the Perth golf course lands started, our community has discovered how easily development can impact these sensitive lands. These powerhouses need our help more than ever.

We are hosting this presentation at our April meeting that will provide more information and will address ways to take action to prevent future developments on wetlands or other sensitive lands.
